WALKING PATTERN
'25-'26
ALL DIVISIONS

Timing Starts Once Title is Called. You will be called from Center Stage.

*You will be cued from
backstage on when to
walk to center.*

HOLD

MARK 1

ONE pose then walk **CONTINUOUSLY**
down the stage to Mark 2. Poses must be front facing.
No turns, spins, pivots or circling into or out of this mark.
No stops or walking turns along the way between Marks 1 + 2 or 2 + 3.
You may do a walking turn between Mark 3 and the final holding spot.

Timing Ends Once You Land Your Final Pose Here.

MARK 3

This is a stop. You may circle,
turn, pivot, or simply walk into this
mark. You may pose/turn/model
however you'd like.

HOLD

FINAL LOOK
Hold here until the next
titleholder is announced.

MARK 2

Please just walk into Mark 2 (do not circle into,
pivot, or spin into this mark). Once you've
landed this mark, you may pose/turn/model
however you'd like.

Average Timing: 50 Seconds
Do not exceed 60 seconds

IMPORTANT

There will be an auditor looking specifically
at adherence to the time limit. A **one-point
deduction** will be taken from a contestant's
average for each event during which she
exceeds the time limit. Judges will also receive
detailed training on the pattern and will take
adherence into account as part of their
scoring process as well.

Timing Starts Once Title is Called. You will be called from Center Stage.

The holding mark may be on a platform for Pre-Teen through Ms. You will be cued from backstage on when to walk to center.

MARK 1

Average Timing: 40 Seconds
Do not exceed 50 seconds

Walking turns are fine; please, no hard stops. Whether or not a turn here is seen as a 'stop' is at the judges' discretion.

Timing Ends Once You Land Your Final Pose Here.

HOLD

FINAL LOOK
Hold here until the next titleholder is announced.

On both Mark 1 and Mark 2, you can model and turn however you'd like.

MARK 2

IMPORTANT

There will be an auditor looking specifically at adherence to the time limit. A **one-point deduction** will be taken from a contestant's average for each event during which she exceeds the time limit. Judges will also receive detailed training on the pattern and will take adherence into account as part of their scoring process as well.
